Gary, as the moderator, led us in the prayer to the Holy Spirit which was followed by **Chuck** leading us in song—"You Are Mine." **Paul** read scripture, Psalms 89:2-5, 27-29, which talks of God's covenant with David. **Dow** read this beautiful prayer, very fitting for the season:

Lenten Prayer for the Holy Spirit's Presence

O Lord, your food was to do the will of the Father, and so we ask you feed us with food that never lets our souls be hungry again: the Word, which is Christ.

Flood our hearts, minds, souls and our community with the divine light of Christ, the bright morning star.

May your Spirit descend upon us as it did at Christ's baptism, that we may be filled with the call to bring the kingdom of God to all the earth.

With wisdom, gifts, and revelation we pray your Spirit fill us, that we may live to further your new and coming kingdom, our inheritance, proclaimed by the body and blood of your resurrection.

Greg gave a very inspiring witness talk that told of how Cursillo has changed his life. Attending Cursillo #90 in October, **Greg** said that he was a "hard nut to crack"; however Jesus pulled him inside out Sunday in the Chapel praying before Holy Eucharist. Holding the Crucifix, a picture came clear in **Greg's** mind of his children with Jesus and the Scripture, "*I Am In You and You Are In Me.*" After coming home from Cursillo, **Greg** was so on fire, which Michael and I both can attest to, that he prayed to Jesus for calming of the Holy Spirit. He has since become a representative for *Lighthouse Catholic Media Ministries*. **Greg** did a comparison/contrast of **Greg** before Cursillo and **Greg** after Cursillo:

Greg concluded by stating that we are all instruments of God and that before Cursillo he was a mess, however, after Cursillo he is a better mess in God's eyes. **Deacon Tom Murray** who made his Cursillo in Hartford, Connecticut in 1977 gave the Spiritual Reflection. Since our Ultreya fell on the Feast of St. Joseph, Deacon Tom Murray spoke about this righteous man, Joseph, filled with faith. Joseph was in the House of Abraham, royalty; however, Joseph was a simple carpenter who listened when God spoke to him. God spoke to Joseph 4 times and each time Joseph did not question, he acted. Joseph was a counselor to Jesus and was never aware that Jesus was the Son of God. Never given a year within our church, God has taken care of that by making Joseph the Protector of the Holy Family, Protector of the Dying, Protector Against the Demons and Guardian of the Universal Church. **Deacon Tom** went on to say that we should learn from Joseph and how we respond to the calls from the Lord Jesus and give our lives to him.

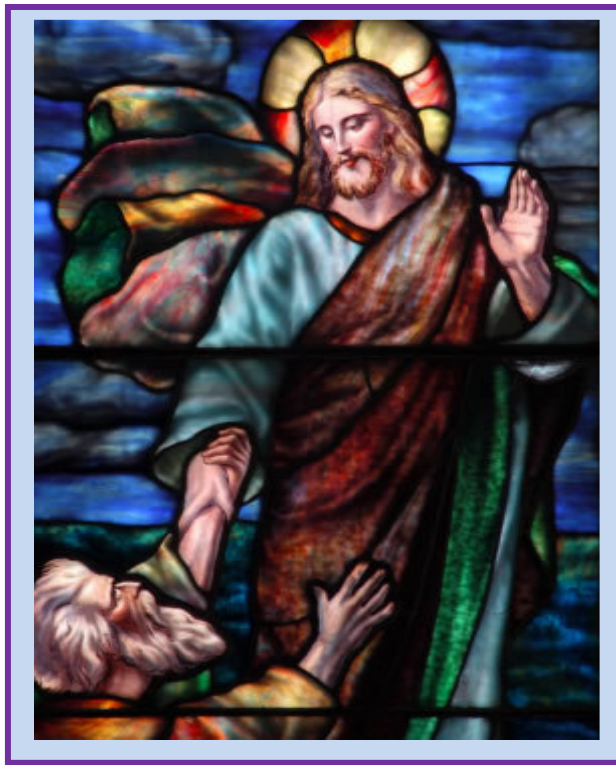
